WRITING COMEDY PILOTS

Some tips and reminders for writing comedy pilots. It's not just about getting laughs! Designing a show takes a lot of thought and planning.

- Make sense first! Confused people don't laugh
- Most of the show happens on dedicated sets. Know what they are
- Have an idea of your target audience. Who do you think will watch it?
- · Consider what network or streaming service might broadcast it
- Create distinct characters who have clearly defined personalities
- Strive to write dialogue that can't be interchanged between characters
- Know all the rules of the universe you are creating and stick to them
- Use status to instigate conflict. A character's status changes. It's not static
- Use specific labeling and pop culture references to get laughs
- Your premise does not have to be unique, your viewpoint does
- Decide whether your show is single-cam or multi-cam before, not after
